## Training

For training purposes, players do not need to wear their playing kit.

Any casual clothes with their shinpads and boots are all that are required.

To allow everyone enough space, different age groups train on different days. All non-competitive teams, from Under 6 through to Under 11 train on Wednesday afternoons at 5.30.

Competitive aged teams train Thursdays at 5.30

## Coaches and Managers

Volunteers will be called for Coach & Manager positions for each team. If there are no volunteers, that team will be unable to play. While there will be a number of returning Coaches & Managers, we are always looking for new coaches and managers. If you or someone that you know would be happy to get involved, please let us know. Training is provided.

## Fees and Inclusions

Our fees include a full playing kit – which includes playing shirt, shorts and socks. This kit is theirs to keep and wear to each game. Your gear will be supplied prior to the season starting, when your fees are paid.

## Registration and Fees

We do not include a weekly fees for our junior (under 18) players. Your one-off fee covers everything that you need for the season, except for your boots and shin pads. These will need to be bought before your first game, as you cannot play without them.

To have your registration fully processed, we need to have your online registration done, including your photo. We cannot guarantee a place in a team until this is completed.

## Playing Kit

Our uniform is a red and white shirt, with white shorts and white socks with a blue band. We are proud of our tradition as one of the oldest clubs in the area and each player must wear their uniform each game.

## Meet Up Day

This is the next day that you will come to the field. It is a time that you can get to meet your team. It is also the opportunity that we can discuss with parents their availability to volunteer to help us this season. All players from Under 6 to Under 11 age groups are requested to attend this day.
